Leadership Redondo is designed to prepare a select group of individuals who live and/or work in Redondo Beach, to become future community leaders. This ten month curriculum includes monthly sessions at locations throughout Redondo Beach, the South Bay and Los Angeles County followed by the implementation of a community project. During the last 6-months, the group will complete a class project.
